During the months of July to October witness one of nature's greatest shows! Herds of wildebeest thousands strong gather on the northern edges of the Serengeti in search of fresh grasses.

As the herds cross into Kenya they must cross the Mara River. Pressure grows as the herds gather at the banks of the river until one finally is forced to take the plunge and HOPE they make it across (watch out for crocs)!

Half Board Accomodations - lunch is additional on this day



DAY 2 - Tarangire National Park



Tarangire Park ~100km from Arusha is famous for its tower baboab trees, large population of elephants, lush landscape and many species of birds and monkeys. Game drive all day in the park with a delicious picnic lunch served on full tableware with a selection of beverages.

DAY 3 - Central Serengeti



After breakfast you will transfer to the Central Serengeti (Seronera). Passing through villages and catching your first glimpses of Lake Manyara and Ngorongoro Crater along the way.

The name Serengeti is thought to be derived from a Maasai word 'serengit' meaning endless plains. The Serengeti certainly seems endless as it spands over 30,000 square kilometers.

Once arriving in Seronera spend the afternoon game driving and exploring!

DAY 5: OPTIONAL Hot Air Balloon Safari






After lunch make the ascent to the crater rim and begin your transfer to Arusha.
